Letter address to Dr. Sudhir Krishna Secretary to Govt. of India, MoUD, N. Bhawan, New Delhi with copy to Shri C.S Prasad DG, CPWD

Subject: Irregular Proposal of revision of Seniority List of Executive Engineers (Civil)-2004 by issuing Provisional Seniority List as on 1.12.2011 by CPWD

Ref: DG, CPWD's OM No. 37/1/2011-EC.I dated 14th December, 2011

Sir,

Kindly refer to the above cited OM vide which the Director General, CPWD has circulated a provisional seniority list of EEs (Civil) in CPWD as on 1.12.2011, inviting objections, if any. **Our Association would like to place on record our strong resentment and objections to the attempt of the Directorate in trying to revise/quash the existing final seniority list of EE (Civil)-2004** (which has been acted upon for many years) on their own conspiring to push down the seniority of departmental officers promoted as per RRs 1954 (in short old rules) unethically below five batches of DR Class – I officers promoted as per RRs 1996 (in short new rules) with the sole aim to degrade/demoralize departmental promotee officers and blatantly favour the DR- Class – I officers by furnishing illogical and unfounded reasons.

The earlier similar effort of Directorate CPWD to revise the final seniority list of EE (Civil)-2004 by holding review DPC in 2010 has been stayed by the Hon'ble Delhi High Court vide order dated 3.6.2010 and 5.10.2010 passed in W.P. No.4004/2010 in the case of Sh. Sushil Kumar Jain & others Vs UOI wherein it has directed to maintain status quo and observed that in view of order dated 05.12.2008 in WPC 2562/2002 the department can not reconsider the promotion which were effected as back as in the year 1999 on 3.11.1999.

Hon'ble High Court of Delhi in its other order in W.P(C)12914/2009 in R.K. Kashyap & others Vs UOI has ordered that the seniority list of 2004 for EEs is for the EEs promoted upto 31.12.96 and if department is to meet the grievances of EEs appointed/promoted after 01.01.97, either a fresh list be drawn up clearly stating it to be supplementary to the earlier list or by way of amendment to existing seniority list, further names could be added. But the Department without taking note of these orders and even without making mention of these orders, is attempting 2nd time to upset seniority of departmental officers by quoting the CAT orders.

We would like to further place the following facts regarding various court cases mentioned in the OM for your kind information and consideration:-

- (a) **Judgment pronounced by CAT, PB, New Delhi on 16th July 2007 in the cases of OA Nos. 779/2006 of CPWD Engineers Association &**

Ors. V/s UOI & Ors, OA No. 1626/2006 of T.K. Majumdar & Anr. V/s UOI & Ors., & OA No. 1349/2006 of Pritpal Singh V/s UOI & Ors.

The applicants were promoted as Executive Engineers (Civil) from the post of Assistant Engineer on 03.11.1999 on regular basis as per 1954 RRs for vacancies upto 28.10.1996 after the diversion of unutilized vacancies from AEE quota to AE quota during July 1999. Most of them were already working as EEs on ad-hoc basis prior to their regularization and they sought relief that their seniority should be counted from the deemed date of regularization. They also sought grant of NFJAG Scale and promotion to the post of Superintending Engineer as per the date of regular promotion which was granted to them by the DG (W) vide order No. 212 of 2001 dated 27.09.01 & 216 of 2001 dated 28.09.01. They relied on the fact that they were promoted against the vacancies of those years only for which they demand deemed date, which is already granted by the above orders.

The Tribunal has not agreed to the above relief and dismissed the petitions finding no merits. The **tribunal opined that the seniority of a person can be counted only from the date on which his services are regularized**, since most of the promotee EEs were regularized **against the diverted vacancies from AEE quota and not within their own quota** which is de hors the RRs against non-existent quota vacancies. **The Tribunal also mentioned that the correct position was reflected in the impugned seniority list dated 10.11.2004 for EE (C).** The CAT (PB) has also refused to quash the seniority list dated 10.11.2004 observing that “objections were called for vide Memorandum dated 14.8.2003, justified objections were taken note of and correct position was reflected in the impugned seniority list.”

(b) Judgment pronounced by CAT, PB, New Delhi on 09th January, 2009 in the case of Sh. B.P. Singh & Anr. Vs UOI & Ors. in OA No. 1310/2008.

The relief sought by the petitioners, who were class I (DR) Engineers promoted as EEs on regular basis as per the 1996 RRs against post 28.10.96 vacancies, to direct the respondents to fix their seniority in the grade of EE (C) and revise the seniority list of EEs dated 10.11.04 **in the light of law laid down by the Tribunal in its judgment dated 16.07.07** in the above OAs and to include their names above all promotee EEs promoted from AEs stream on 03.11.99. Based on the seniority so fixed they sought to be promoted as SE on regular basis along with all consequential benefits. The additional respondents contended that there is suppression of facts as well as laches by the applicants but the Tribunal thought not to go to minute details for disposal of this OA.

The applicants themselves were regularly promoted by order dated 06.07.99 with assigned date of regular promotion as 15.07.97. But their names do not figure in the seniority list of EEs published on 10.11.04 which needs correction to set right the omission. The contention of official respondents that a Writ petition is pending in the High Court did not have any effect on the application as felt by the Tribunal. The Tribunal mentioned that the **official respondents have not disputed the genuineness and basis of the claim.** Therefore the Tribunal directed that **the seniority list should be properly subjected to a recasting after noticing claims of this OA and if the claims are found tenable, by giving general notice departmentally, their names are to be interpolated at appropriate place to indicate their right full position in the seniority list.** The Tribunal felt it is essential that a flawless seniority list should be operated.

The order dated 9.1.2009 of CAT (PB) in OA1310/2008 which was based on orders dated 16.7.2007 of CAT (PB) in OA No.779/2006 with OA 1626/2006 & OA 1349/2006 Delhi has been set aside by Hon'ble High Court of Delhi vide order dated 27.7.2010 in CWP 12914/2009 in matter of R.K. Kashyap and others v/s UOI. Hon'ble High Court decided that seniority list dated 10.11.2004 as final in all respects with regard to promotions made as per 1954 rules. The Writ Petition No. 3983/2011 (SS Nirmal case) was dismissed merely on the ground of delay and not on its merits.

- (c) Judgment pronounced by Division Bench of Delhi High Court on 05th December, 2008 in the case of CES Class-I (DR) Association & Ors. Vs UOI & Ors. in WP (C) No. 2562 of 2002 (and Sh. V.K. Jain Vs UOI & Ors. in WP (C) No. 489 of 2000).

The petitioners in WP(C) 2562/02 are directly recruited AEEs (C) class-I, whose quota of vacancies for promotion to the grade of EE was diverted in favour of AEs. The main question for the consideration of the court was: **whether, in exercise of the power of relaxation conferred by statutory rules, the Central Government is entitled to divert vacancies, en bloc, belonging to the quota of direct recruits to the quota of promotees, in order to regularize their promotion?** The High Court decided that, given the facts and circumstances of the case, as well as the legal position, their answer to this question is in the affirmative.

While categorically **upholding the action of Government to divert all unused pre 28.10.96 vacancies** of EEs from AEE quota to AE quota as per rule 25 of 1954 RRs, regularization of AEs' promotions as EEs upto 28.10.96 and their relative seniority granted in the seniority lists, the High Court also interalia said that:

1. AEs who can be considered for promotion as EEs, include both graduate engineers as well as diploma engineers (para 5).
2. The promotions made were quite disproportionate to the quota and the fall-out of this was that many of the AEs continued as Ad-hoc EEs and even retired as such without the benefit of regularization (para 6).
3. In our opinion, on the plain language of the 1996 Rules, this power (to relax) was available to the central government under the 1954 Rules in respect of pre-1996 promotions (para 20).
4. Therefore, by correcting the course of events, no prejudice has been caused to the AEEs. Indeed, as far as we are concerned, nothing was shown to us to even remotely suggest that the petitioners were prejudicially affected. That being so, we failed to see the grievance that any of the petitioner could have to the remedial action taken by the central government (para 21).
5. To our mind, this clearly suggests that not only were the petitioners required to undergo a qualifying period of service for promotion to the post of EE, but that their promotions were made under the 1996 Rules and not under the 1954 Rules. This really confirms that the petitioner have not been prejudicially affected in any manner whatsoever (para 24).
6. The only Rules that could be considered for application to pre-1996 promotions are undoubtedly the 1954 Rules and it is only the power conferred by those rules that the Central Government has invoked (para25).
7. Rule 7 of the 1996 Rules deals with filling up of vacant duty posts, by way of future maintenance of the service created by the 1996 Rules. In the present case, the situation contemplated by learned Counsel does not at all arise because **by the order dated 06.7.1999 all promotions of ad-hoc AEs were regularized leaving no “vacant duty posts” to be filled up. In fact, by virtue of their regularization, the AEs became members of the Central Engineering (Civil) Group A Service on its initial constitution under Rule 6 of the 1996 Rules.** To sum up, there is no visible impact of the 1996 Rules on the 1954 Rules as far as this case is concerned (para 26).
8. It is nobody’s case that rule 25 of the 1954 Rules confers Arbitrary powers or has been applied arbitrarily. Indeed, this cannot even be the case of the petitioners because **there does appear to be adequate justification for invoking the power of relaxation in its widest amplitude (para 29).**

9. The AEEs were not prejudiced in any manner what so ever. Taking all these aspects into consideration as well as the fact that there was strict compliance with the procedure laid down in the 1954 Rules, **we are of the opinion that not only was an extremely wide power of relaxation available to the Central Government, but that it did right in exercising the power conferred by the 1954 Rules. If in doing so, there was a change in the quota rule it was quite justified and permissible**, if not inevitable. Moreover given the facts of the case, we are not inclined to upset the apple cart on this ground alone (para 35).
10. Given the wide power of relaxation, we cannot, on the facts of this case, find fault with the course adopted by the Central Government (para 37).
11. The Central Government took a deliberate policy decision to regularize the promotions to streamline the cadre management for facilitating the smooth working of the department. **This policy decision is certainly not arbitrary or whimsical nor it has been shown to be so (para 38).**
12. To sum up, we are of the opinion that Rule 25 of 1954 Rules permitted diversion of vacancies (para 39).
13. **This direction of Supreme Court in J.N. Goel case could not be carried out in isolation or by overlooking the rights, concerns and aspirations of graduate AEs.** It is this compulsion that necessitated a wholesale review of the impact of ad-hoc promotions of AEs to the grade of Executive Engineer, leading up to the office memorandum dated 06-07-1999. **To conclude, the Central Government correctly appreciated J.N. Goel particularly the principles laid down in that decision and rightly acted on them (para 40).**
14. We find that the petitioners have made out no case for interference with the impugned order of the Tribunal (para 41).

Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in J. N. Goel case judgment dated 14.1.1997 stated that "Since the 1954 Rules wherein operations prior to promulgation of the 1996 Rules, regular promotion from post of Executive Engineers against vacancies which occurred prior to the promulgation of the rules will be governed by the 1954 rules"

Hon'ble CAT vide order dated 9.05.2002 in OA No. 2026/2000 directed the department to convene a DPC to fill up all the vacancies falling under Recruitment Rules 1954 (Old Rules) and also decided that **"Those of the applicants who are selected for promotion would be entitled for all consequential benefits from the date on which such vacancies arose, on notional basis.** The aforesaid order of the tribunal has been challenged by

Central Engineering Services Class-I(DR) Association in WP(C) 858/2003 and similar other order dated 5.12.2000 of tribunal in OA 58/2000 challenged by Shri Gurbaaz Singh and Others (DR Class – I officers) in WP(C) 840/2003 before Delhi High Court. Both these cases are pending in High Court of Delhi and the next date of hearing is 16/01/2012.

The Hon'ble Court has been pleased to pass interim orders. Contents of interim orders are reproduced below:

Interim order dated 30.03.2006 of Hon'ble High Court in the aforesaid writ petitions, "On issue of seniority to be reckoned from the date of occurrence of the vacancies, the eventual directions shall be passed by high Court at the time of final disposal of writ petition." The administration has also made a number of ad-hoc promotions to the post of EE since April-2006 onwards. The pre-1996 RR vacancies against which ad-hoc promotions were made are 74 in Civil and 6 in Electrical streams. The remaining are as per 1996 RRs. All these ad-hoc promotions are to be regularized as per the relevant RRs and their seniority shall be fixed/determined by the Delhi High Court when the WP(C) 840/2003 and 848/2003 are decided. Till this issue is decided, no seniority lists can be issued for promotions made under old or new RRs

From the above it is clear that;

- (a) The Seniority list-2004 has not been set aside/ quashed or stayed by any court and is legally valid.
- (b) There is no rule/ direction of any court to place the officers promoted as per Recruitment Rules 1996 above the officers promoted as per Recruitment Rules 1954.
- (c) DOP&T's OM dated 3.3.2008 mentioned in subject DGW Office Memorandum No. 37/1/2011-EC.I dated 14th December, 2011 has also been misunderstood and applied in this case as it is applicable to decide relative seniority of direct recruits and promotees and is not applicable for deciding inter se seniority of EEs in CPWD because **all the EEs from both streams (AE & AEE) are promotees**. Moreover, that circular itself states that "Cases of seniority already decided with reference to any other interpretation of the term 'available' as contained in O.M. dated 3.7.1986 need not be reopened".
- (d) The RRs 1954 applicable before 28.10.1996 do not allow placing of persons promoted from different streams i.e. AEEs and AEs in the ratio of 1:2 or 1:1:1 as has been proposed by the department through this provisional seniority list - 1.12.2011.

- (e) The promotion orders dated 3.11.1999 are legally valid. **The AEs who retired before 3.11.99 were also promoted on regular basis retrospectively vide these orders. By issuing provisional seniority list dated 1.12.2011 their status has been left unexplained.**
- (f) The superfluous issuance of provisional seniority list-1.12.2011 by including the names of EEs (DR- Class – I officers) promoted against vacancies occurred after 28.10.96 as per 1996 Rules (New Rules) above the EEs (Departmental promotes) promoted vide order dated 3.11.1999 as per 1954 Rules (Old Rules) is exactly what was the pleading of AEEs (DR- Class – I officers) before Hon'ble High Court in WP(C) 2562/2002 and which was totally rejected by the Hon'ble High Court in its order dated 5.12.2008.
- (g) The aforesaid proposal will totally nullify the OM dated 6.7.1999. Diversion of vacancies vide OM dated 6.7.1999 (430 of civil and 120 of electrical) has been up held by Delhi High Court by order dated 5.12.2008 in WP(C) 2562/2002.

In view of the facts given above, efforts to interfere with the existing position of Executive Engineers in the final seniority list-2004 by issuing provisional seniority list dated 1.12.2011 shall be illegal, malicious, contemptuous and against the principles of natural justice.

It is, therefore, requested that provisional seniority list dated 1.12.2011 circulated vide DG's Office Memorandum No. 37/1/2011-EC.I dated 14th December, 2011 be withdrawn and a supplementary seniority list of officers promoted as per new rules and as also advised by Hon'ble High Court Delhi in order dated **27.7.2010 in CWP 12914/2009 in matter of R.K. Kashyap** and others v/s UOI, be drawn as per quota-rota system. The Director General, CPWD may kindly be advised that administration should not act in a partisan manner as a patron of one group and against the interests of other cadres for overall healthy environment.

To explain this issue in detail, we may kindly be given opportunity to discuss this matter in person at a convenient date and time please.

OFFICE ORDER NO. 23 of 2012

Consequent upon the introduction of MACP scheme in the Department and on completion of 30 years of regular service from initial appointment in the grade of Junior Engineer (Civil & Elect.), the President of India is pleased to grant the 3rd financial up gradation in the grade pay of Rs. 7600/- (Pay Band-3) under MACP scheme to the Assistant Engineer (Civil & Elect.) as per list enclosed at Annexure I & II with effect from the date mentioned against their name.

2. In case, any of the officers in the enclosed list has taken voluntary retirement, resigned or expired, on or before 01.09.2008 i.e the date of MACP becomes effective the financial up gradation may not be given to them by Controlling Officers. Before financial benefit is given, they may also ensure that no vigilance case is either pending or contemplated against the officer to whom the MACP has been granted vide this order. It may also be ensured that no charge-sheet is pending against them/no penalty has been awarded to them on the date of granting the 3rd financial up gradation. In such an event, the fact may be brought to the notice of this Directorate immediately for a decision.

3. Further action may be taken by the controlling Officer for financial up gradation in terms of Department of Personnel & Training O.M. No. 35034/1/97- Estt.-D Dated 9th August, 1999 & 10th February, 2000.

4. On up gradation under MACP Scheme, pay of an employee shall be fixed under the provisions of FR-22(1)(a)(1). The financial benefit allowed under MACP scheme shall be final and no pay fixation benefit shall accrue at the time of regular promotion. In other words, up gradation under MACP Scheme shall be treated as par with regular promotion in so far as pay fixation is concerned. Therefore, the option of pay fixation in the next higher grade based on the date of increment in the lower grade of pay may also be allowed. This fact may please be brought to the notice of all the officers concerned who may like to exercise such an option.

5. All Concerned officers, who are being granted 3rd financial up-gradation under MACP Scheme, before any up-gradation is given, shall give an undertaking that they will refund the amount so paid, if any changes are made by Govt. in MACP Scheme and if due to such changes, recovery becomes due.
